#### 2. Background and Justification

The village of **Nkolessono**, located 73 km from Yaoundé, has a population of approximately 645. Access to drinking water is limited, with only 43.5% of the rural population having access to a potable water source.

Residents rely on unprotected sources, leading to waterborne diseases such as typhoid and dysentery.

# Problematic:

- · Lack of centralized drinking water system.
- · Use of unprotected water sources, causing disease.
- · Increased workload for women and children.

#### Justification:

This project addresses an urgent need for access to clean water, reducing waterborne diseases, improving living conditions and freeing up time for educational and economic activities.

# 3. Project Objectives

# General Objective:

Provide sustainable access to drinking water to the residents of Nkolessono.

# Specific Objectives:

- 1. Drill a borehole equipped with a solar pump and a distribution network.
- 2. Raise awareness among the population about good hygiene and water management practices.
  - 3. Promote the use of renewable energy (solar).
  - 4. Reduce inequalities in access to water through strategic standpipes.
  - 5. Establish a community management committee to ensure the sustainability of the project.

# 4. Technical Description of the Project Selected Solution:

Mini drinking water supply (AEP) with solar pumping.

#### System Components:

- 1. **Drilling**: Construction of a borehole equipped with a submersible solar pump.
- 2. Drinking Water Treatment Unit: Reverse osmosis water treatment.
- 3. Storage Tank: 10000L tank.
- 4. **Distribution Network**: Installation of fire hydrants and private connections.

5. **Ability**: The system will provide approximately 20 liters of water per person per day for 645 residents.



# 5. Beneficiaries

# Direct Beneficiaries:

• 645 inhabitants of Nkolessono (45% children, 24% men, 21% women, 10% elderly people). Indirect Beneficiaries:

• Around 100 villagers from neighboring towns in case of specific needs.

- **Strengthening local capacities**: Establishment of a community management committee.
- **Time saving for women and children**: Redirection of time towards education and economic activities.
- **Reducing environmental impact**: Use of solar energy.
- **Improving hygiene**: Raising awareness of good hygiene practices.

# 8. Challenges and Risks

- **Technical Challenges**: Difficulties related to drilling (soil quality, depth of the water table).
- **Sustainability**: Risk of equipment failure without proper maintenance.
- **Community Participation**: Need to involve residents to ensure ownership of the project.

# 9. Conclusion

This project aims to transform the lives of the residents of **Nkolessono** by providing them with sustainable access to clean drinking water. By combining modern infrastructure, renewable energy, and strong community involvement, this project will have a lasting impact on health, education, and local economic development.
